

Call for Application for Sponsorship to attend McGill Summer Course

With aim of capacity building in research in Infectious Diseases and faculty exchange at Manipal Academy of Higher Education, MAC ID sponsors deserving faculty to attend online McGill Summer Courses organized by McGill University, Canada.

McGill University and McGill University Health Centre offers several short courses on infectious diseases from May 31 - June 18, 2021, wherein 9 courses are offered over three weeks.

- Clinical Tropical & Geographic Medicine - Monday-Wednesday

These courses are being conducted by internationally renowned faculty and encompass excellent lectures and panel discussions, offer numerous chances to network, collaborate, and provide opportunities to meet policy makers from disease-endemic countries

This year 20 candidate will be sponsored by MAC ID for the McGill Summer course

MAC ID will cover registration fees of the selected candidates for attending this online course.

Eligibility criteria:

- Open only to MAC ID members who have ≥ 3 years of experience as faculty

- The awardees are expected to submit their report to MAC ID within 15 days of attending Online McGill Summer course.
- The Faculty should develop and submit a Seed grant proposal to MAC ID during the next Seed Grant Award Competition. This might also be in collaboration with McGill Faculty
- If the Summer Course awardee is a recipient of MAC ID Seed Grant previously, such awardee is required to develop and submit a new full grant proposal for extramural funding within 1 year of attending this online course. This might also be in collaboration with McGill Faculty
- The awardees should hold capacity building workshops in areas of their respective strengths within 1 year, to disseminate the experience gained in collaboration with their Department and MAC ID.

Selection Process:

The applications will be reviewed by the MAC ID Core Committee of Manipal Academy of Higher Education and the Faculty will be selected by them. It will be scored on the following points:

Criteria	Score
Why they want to attend summer course?	10
Value they can bring to Manipal Academy of Higher Education (including capacity building workshop)	20
The experience and publication history in the topic which he/she has chosen for summer course	20
Total	50
