Request for Application (RFA) for Seed grant from Manipal Center for Infectious Diseases (MAC ID) for the year 2025-2026

Description of the Seed Grant Program:

The goal of Manipal Center for Infectious Diseases (MAC ID) seed grant award is to encourage faculty members of MAHE in research in the area of infectious diseases and generate a critical mass of fundamental information/pilot data which can further help the investigators to develop proposals for extramural funding. Proposals must show a clear plan to seek further funding after the seed grant period has ended. The applicant must clearly and convincingly demonstrate that the proposed project represents a research direction in an area likely to generate extramural funding.

Seed grants of **INR 3 lakh** each will be awarded to deserving proposals. Grants are non-renewable. Duration of the seed grant projects should be **1 year 10 Months**. **A total of 4 grants** are awarded.

Eligibility

- The principal investigator must be a member of MAC ID and a faculty of MAHE; the co-investigator (s) may be member/non-member.
- > Seed grant is open to all areas of Infectious Diseases
- > Duration of project should be 1 year 10 Months
- ➤ A MAC ID member can submit one seed grant application as the principal-investigator; however, can be a co-investigator in one other grant application.

Ineligible projects:

- ➤ Members who have current funding ≥10 Lakhs as Principal Investigator are not eligible toapply for MAC ID seed grants
- > The previous seed grant awardees are ineligible to apply.
- Research that is already supported by other sources or fellowships (including TMA Pai student Fellowship).

Grant Administration

The fund will be held at MAHE finance, earmarked for the awardee. The utilization of the fund

will have to follow MAHE guidelines. Purchase request has to be placed through online

purchase system routed through MAC ID for approval, for the purchase of the required material.

Final Reporting

1. Within two months of the close of the project a statement of expenditure must be

submitted to the MAC ID. A template will be provided.

Normal research expenditures including supplies, salaries for research personnel, are

permitted. Funds should not be used to (a) purchase equipment, (b) cover travel

expenses related to conferences (c) support salary of PIs or co-applicants

2. Within two months of the close of the project a brief scientific report must be

submitted to the MAC ID along with the 250-word abstract.

3. The Results obtained from this study must be published in Scopus indexed scientific

journals. The award money may be utilized for publication charges. The seed grant

support from Manipal Center for Infectious Diseases must be acknowledged in

publications. Seed Grant Awardee has to be the First Author or Correspondence Author

(Principle Investigator) in the ensuring publication.

4. Seed grant awardees must produce a new proposal for extramural funding as the final

report within one year of completion of the project.

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
